This is why we were able to have a late start on Tuesday while public schools were remote (many of them would have liked to have a late start but various factors did not allow them to). So in the future, there may be days that public schools have to call off for cold weather, but we may have school because we do not have a bus system or very many, if any, students who have to walk. Student safety is always our number one concern and will take priority when making decisions. When we are able, getting our students in the classroom is always more beneficial to their academic progress than days off or remote learning. I thank you for your patience and understanding. Please know that I have not taken any of these decisions lightly - in fact, the last couple of weeks may have been my most stressful yet this year! - Mrs. Fox
